The Utah High School Activities Association & USA Wrestling Utah are proud to present the 2013 Super State Wrestling Championships at the Maverik Center in West Valley City.

QUALIFIERS FROM THE STATE CLASSIFICATION TOURNAMENTS

Super State qualifiers from the State Classification Tournaments will be entered in the Super State Wrestling Championships by the Director of the tournament. All entries must be confirmed by email the Tuesday (February 19) before the Super State Wrestling Championships. First and last names must be confirmed as well as year in school and the wrestler's 2012-13 varsity record. This information must be confirmed by coaches via email to the Tournament Director. **Qualifying for the 2013 Super State Wrestling Championships will include 28 wrestlers per weight class comprised of the state classification tournament placewinners – the top 6 in 5A-4A-3A-2A and the top 4 in 1A.** Jeff Newby will serve as the Super State Tournament Director and can be reached via email at jeffreynewby@hotmail.com. ADMISSION OF WRESTLERS AND TEAM PERSONNEL

Each participating school will be issued four (4) tickets and floor access passes. Wrestlers competing in the tournament will receive a stamp as they enter the first time each day that will admit them for the rest of the day. **Wrestlers and coaches will enter through the Will Call VIP Entry to the left of the main steps to the south side entrance.** A participant check-in list will allow wrestlers & their coaches into the building through the wrestlers' entrance the first time each day. All others must have a ticket or pass and will be admitted through the main entrance doors. School trainers will be admitted if listed on the school trainers' list approved by the UHSAA. To be listed, certified trainers should contact Bart Thompson at Thompson@uhsaa.org.

WEIGH-IN; SKIN CHECK

The Weigh-in will take place in the Golden Corridor area on the Gold Level of the Maverik Center. The weigh-in will be conducted by weight class according to UHSAA rule 4-5-3. **Wrestlers will receive 1 pound additional weight allowance from the State Classification tournaments on Friday February 22 and an additional 1 pound allowance on Saturday February 23.** An on-site, designated meet physician will be present to rule on suspect skin conditions. Wrestlers should be prepared to present their own physician's statement at this time. Wrestlers with scratches or abrasions may be required to cover them for their own protection from potential infection. The Super State Wrestling Championships will observe UHSAA rules 4-2-4, 4-2-3 & 4-5-7 as it contains to Weigh-In rules and Skin Check decisions.

COACHES INFORMATION

A coaches meeting will be held on the first day of the tournament on Friday, February 22 at 3pm in the VIP Conference Center.

The tournament will be run using Trackwrestling software. Brackets will be updated and available from a link on the Wrestling page of the UHSAA website www.uhsaa.org and on the www.trackwrestling.com web-site throughout the tournament. Paper brackets of each weight class (1 per school) will only be available each morning of the tournament.

AWARDS

First place champion plaques will be awarded in all weight classes with the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th & 6th place wrestlers receiving medals. No team scoring will be kept at the Super State Wrestling Championships.
